is a visual representation of how the industrialisation of the ocean is being pursued. It emulates the dream of British mining magnate and politician, Cecil Rhodes, who famously dreamed of a "red-line" denoting British dominions in Africa and the Cape-to-Cairo rail line as key to securing resources, military movements and imperial control.

It tells a parallel story of how powerful external forces follow resources right across our Blue Pacific continent, mapping out vast expanses of ocean space and planting their flags to mark what they consider to be theirs.

The Blue Pacific continent covers 1/3 of the earth's surface. It shapes Pacific peoples culture, identity and values that are intertwined with the marine environment.
